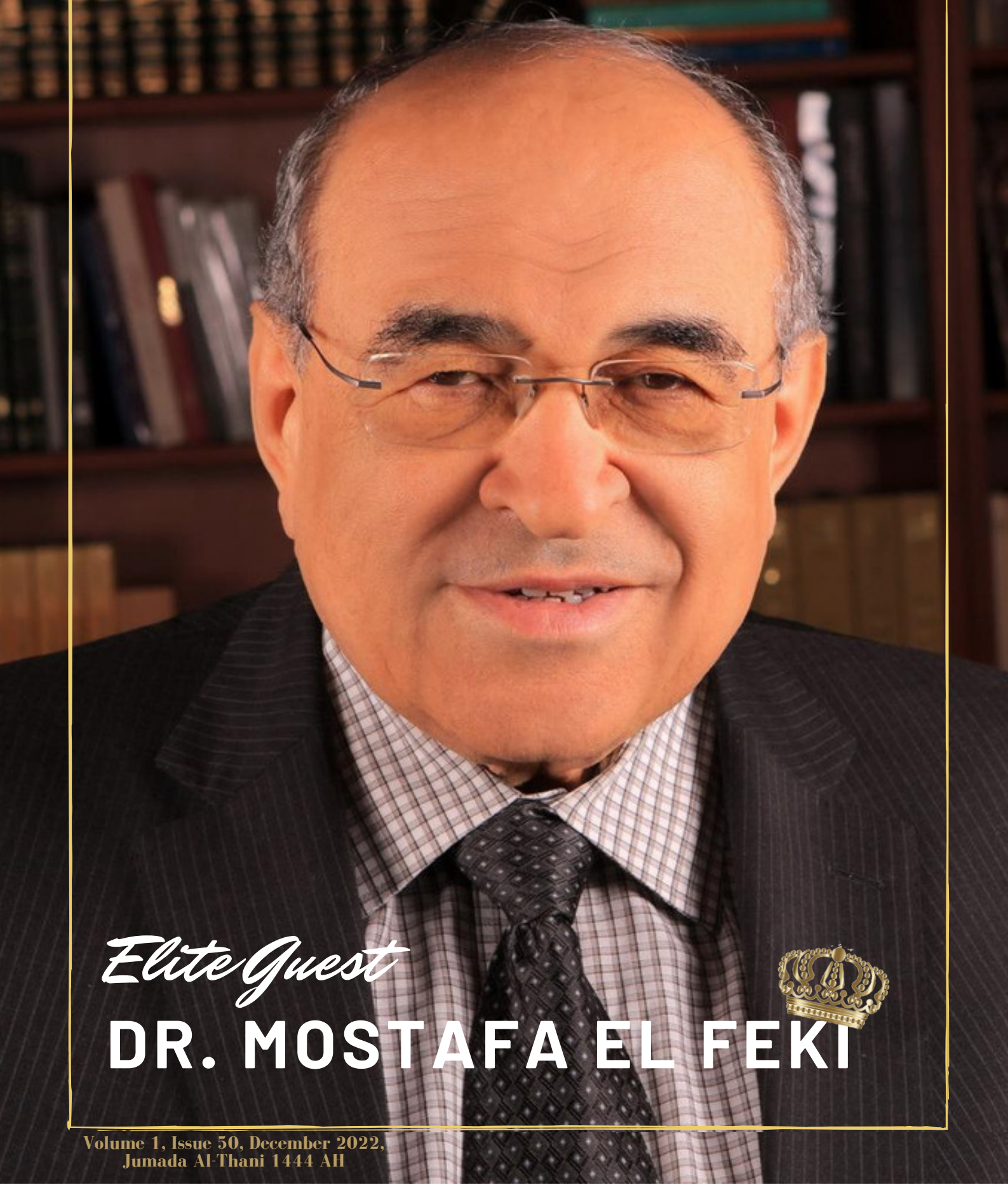

Dr. Mostafa El Feki, Prominent Politician and Diplomat, hosted by ELITE

Among the most prominent political and diplomatic figures in Egypt, we chose this month to host Dr. Mostafa El Feki, who held many high positions. He previously held the position of Presidential Secretary for Information and Follow-up, as well as the position of Director of the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, in addition to his management of the Institute of Diplomatic Studies and his great parliamentary experience, and this is to name a few. Dr. Mostafa El Feki was born in Mahmoudia Center, Beheira Governorate, on November 14, 1944. He obtained a bachelor's degree from the Faculty of Economics and Political Science at Cairo University in 1966, then a master's degree in political science from the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) at the University of London in 1974, and he was awarded a doctorate from the University of London in 1977 to join the diplomatic corps and work in the embassies of Egypt in Britain and India.

Dr. Mostafa El Feki enriched the Arabic library with several books, including Snapshots of a Lifetime, Characters on the Road (I knew them closely), the Dialogue of the Era, What Happened to Egypt, The Big Bang and Creative Chaos, Years of Lost Opportunities,

The Philosophy of the Universe and the Balance of Existence, The Arabs from the Jurisprudence of Conspiracy to the Thought of Freedoms, The Egyptian State and the Modern Vision, Islam in a changing world, One People and One Homeland. He received many awards, including the Best Book Award in Political Thought from the Cairo International Book Fair, the State Incentive Award in 1994, the Order of Science and Arts of the First Class from the Government of Austria in 1998, the State Appreciation Award in Social Sciences in 2003, and many other awards.

We were pleased that Dr. Mostafa El Feki accepted our invitation, as he welcomed the visit to the college, with which he is always keen to communicate, and we were honored by this dialogue with His Excellency:

• What are your most vivid memories of Dr. Boutros-Ghali? He replied:

Dr. Boutros Ghali, I have all the pride, love, and appreciation in the world for him. Dr. Boutros Ghali is the first person to nominate me for diplomatic work in India, and ironically, I did not welcome this news at first because the booklet issued to diplomatic attachés about India at the time was full of disadvantages, such as the outbreak of



several diseases, and this matter made me upset and frustrated at first, especially since my first diplomatic job was in the British capital, but Dr. Boutros-Ghali put his hands on the fact that India is more important than European countries and nominated skilled cadres for it. So I accepted the job. I discovered that the experience in India was very useful and added a lot to me in the field of diplomatic work, so I am very grateful to Dr. Boutros-Ghali for providing this experience at the level of humanitarian dealings as well, as he constantly checked on me and visited me every year.

· On the occasion of opening the door of memories, we asked Dr. Mostafa about his memories of the faculty, and we know that he had a close relationship with the faculty and its important activities over many years, and he said:

The Faculty of Economics and Political Science is my first home where I grew up at the hands of distinguished professors, most notably Dr. Rifaat Al-Mahjoub, Dr. Abdulmalek Odeh, and Dr. Ali Al-Din Hilal. I am very happy with the development witnessed by this prestigious college in terms of buildings, expansions, and lecture halls after there were previously only two auditoriums within the Faculty of Law.

· As we are hosting a high-class politician, we had to ask Dr. Mostafa El Feki about his analysis of the current international situation, the challenges, and

opportunities available to Egypt in the context of this situation. He said:

The international situation is becoming more complicated, and the United States is playing a dangerous role, which is to motivate European countries against Russia, that led to the outbreak of the Russian-Ukrainian war. Its goal is to exhaust Russia without Washington directly intervening, and although it was the main driver of the Europeans against Russia in this crisis, it does not intervene to help them in energy crises, for example. The United States is not interested in Europe as it did in the past but is now focusing more on the world's powers, the foremost of which is China, which represents its largest economic competitor, and is currently almost back to Monroe's principle of isolation (proclaimed by US President James Monroe in 1823, which guarantees the independence of all countries of the Western Hemisphere against European interference). I think that the war will continue for several more months and then end with negotiations, but after Russia is greatly exhausted militarily. It is noteworthy that during the Ukrainian war, talk began for the first time in the world about the possibility of resorting to nuclear weapons and threatening to use them in Russia, and this is very dangerous as it indicates that the world has become less safe.



• **We asked Dr. Mostafa about his reading of the future of the Arab region in light of the current challenges of terrorism, ethnic conflicts, and the Zionist presence, which make it a hotspot for political and economic crises, and he said:**

The Palestinian issue will remain the main issue for the Arabs amid efforts to solve to establish a Palestinian state on the 1967 borders with East Jerusalem as its capital, and there is a vision that this situation can be reached through negotiation and normal relations with former enemies. The nature of conflicts in the region has changed, and new issues such as terrorism have emerged. All challenges must be addressed.

• **We asked Dr. Mostafa El Feki, based on the reality of his long experience in diplomatic work, about the advice he gives to students who are looking to join this high corps and how they can prepare well for the entrance exams, and he said:**

The most important thing that must distinguish the applicant to work in the diplomatic corps is that he must be balanced, confident in himself and his abilities, broad in culture and knowledge, have a great degree of awareness of all developments at all levels and be linguistically accurate in the selection of his vocabulary. Psychological balance is important, and during the tests, a psychoanalyst prepares a

questionnaire about the applicant's level of balance. I would like to emphasize that the graduates of the Faculty of Economics and Political Science at Cairo University are qualified as of the first academic year to pass these exams as a result of their distinguished academic studies. The graduates of this college are distinguished from their fellow graduates at the level of the Republic in terms of academic knowledge and practical application.

At the end of the fruitful meeting with Dr. Mostafa El Feki, we thanked him for providing this opportunity, which we were pleased with. We were keen to take group photos of the distinguished professors with the magazine team.

Behavioralism and Political Science

Political science is closely related to behavioral theory, and this connection results in several things, including a constant attempt to reach the degree and status of Natural Sciences and remove everything that prevents us from doing so, in order to reach that status, values are separated from facts. Is this a blessing or a curse.

Being too involved in separating values from facts and completely disposing of them leads to reaching a state of nihilism, that is, the inability to sense and distinguish, and as soon as a person or researcher reaches this state, he becomes isolated and does not interact with reality. he cannot explain or predict the phenomenon, but only describe it, and in some cases, it is difficult for the researcher to describe it as well. this can be cited from the state of political science in Egypt during the January revolution, no one foresaw the outbreak of a revolution in the first place, and no one expected that this revolution would be with such overwhelming force that it would be able to overthrow the regime, also, if we look at the term Arab Spring itself, we will find that it was launched from the West, and the Arabs did not even have a role In naming the phenomenon.

And the question that occurs after the discussion of this paragraph: does this mean that it is necessary to completely abandon the behavioral theory in order to solve this problem But if you do this, you will lose the ability to connect the phenomena and know the extent to which the variables affect each other, and therefore we will lose the ability

We also need to reach generalizations that make it easier for us to develop general laws that help us understand and simplify the events taking place in the world around us.

So what is the way if it is dispensed with I find it difficult and even impossible to completely abandon the behavioral theory, but we can recognize the importance of values and work on studying them in a scientific way so that we can integrate them or at least recognize their existence without denying them And that's because I believe in the impossibility of the absence of values from people, how this is the main engine and motivation for some of the directions we take, the choices we make, and the actions we do.



The challenges of “Balancing” Labor, Unions, and Profitability : Meeting Amazon CEO Andy Jassy

At the annual conference of Dealbook Summit’22 held in NYC, Andy Jassy who got the job of Amazon CEO in the middle of the pandemic, discuss the effect of an uncertain economy on investments and profitability, he also shed light on the problems of the Labor unions and the layoff occurred by Amazon. The company was in super growth mode and trying to build out to deal with all the consumers out there. The stock was through the roof and people probably didn’t anticipate it. In 2020, Amazon’s retail business grew 39 % year over year and 245 billion dollars in annual run rate which is unprecedented, and it forced Amazon to spend a lot more money and to go much faster in building infrastructure than ever imagined. That decision was made even though the uncertainty of overbuilding because it took two years to build fulfillment centers at that time. It was hard for Amazon to imagine what 2021 was going to be like because it looked like the economic agents were coming out of the pandemic but then Omicron happened and the war in Ukraine happened, and then the inflationary environment happened and now all agents must deal with this very uncertain economy. Amazon has found over time that consumers are very careful about whom they choose to partner with, they go with people and companies that are going

to provide them with a great customer experience and that has always been something that Amazon has focused very squarely on. This year, the leaders of Amazon had the lens of a very uncertain economic environment as well as having hired very aggressively over the last several years, the right decision needed was to streamline their cause and their goal by streamlining cut costs but at the same time without compromising on the key strategic long-term best change so they examine a lot of operating plans and they realized that some of their cost structure, by considering different sensitivities, was not as they expected to be so they started to pause incremental hiring as well as being slimmer on some of their resources.

Amazon has been confronting challenges concerning the labor issue and the battle of workers’ unions. Amazon workers at a warehouse in Albany voted no on a union while the workers in Staten Island voted yes. As the state of this dynamic, Andy Jassy state that labor unions aren’t favorable for Amazon because they were more bureaucratic, slow, and limited agility which is fairly non-controversial and straightforward but for Andy Jassy, the truth is that Amazon employees are better off without union for a few reasons one is that Amazon aims to Empower their employees, if they find ways that they can make the experience better for customers or their fellow



teammates, they can go fix because this is a pretty empowering and a great way to work and have a direct relationship with your manager. Amazon hearing from all their employees is more effective than having it filtered through one or two voices. When there are unions, you often end up with this “us VS them” mentality that's not as productive when you're trying to invent and accomplish. if Amazon wants to operate in the same structure she has without unions, she must have compelling benefits, and its why Amazon upholds certain labor policies like the 19 dollars minimum wage per hour and starting hourly salary and full health insurance, and 41K dollars in up to 20 weeks of Parental leave and providing this career choice program funded where our employees in the Fulfillment center have options between an advanced education or college. those set of benefits has been accomplished without a union.

According to Andy Jassy a lot of companies have different strategies for how they think about Investments and there is no one right way to do it but the way amazon thinks about strategic Investments depends on the level of success, customer service extension, differentiated approach and most important the confidence Amazon has in that area. That process leads to Investments that are more predictable. Amazon’s investment in emerging geographies was one of its biggest Investments in India and Brazil, Turkey and Mexico which are huge investment areas because it’s already over 25 billion dollars in Gross merchandise grocery space. Going to live in a world of omnichannel is predictable for people but sometimes that process yields Investments that aren't as obvious. AWS (Amazon Web Service), for example, is very Capital intensive but there is a handful of companies that have the technical inventive aptitude. Investments like Kuiper or Zoox (autonomous driving ride-hailing service) or Alexa have a lot of optimism about those bets, and the history of Amazon suggests that one of them may become that fourth pillar on top of the marketplace. The next year or two with this economic environment is going to test the long-term resolution of a lot of companies and they're going to be a lot of companies who decide that they're going to basically stop doing anything that's not their core Revenue generating businesses. Amazon’s approach is streamlining their costs in a bunch of different areas while betting on the things that they believe in the long-term could change.



Considering acquisition in the investment climate, Amazon has done two Acquisitions relatively because they are super close to the main part of core businesses but Acquisitions in this period will be interesting, like Microsoft and Activision which is a core part of their video business so it’s interesting to see what happens in the gaming space. Your paragrThe case of acquisition deals like Microsoft and Activision, whether they are bad or good for competition and in general the idea of big companies -that have lots of financial power buying adjacent businesses that they're able to subsidize as they've grown- has been the success of a lot of the business model at Amazon. As Andy Jassy states: “when you have a company that has a very large share acquiring another company that has a very large share in the same precise space, it’s difficult for companies to build the right scalable experiences for customers.”

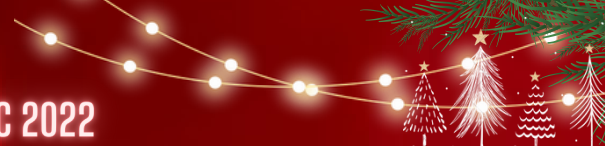
To be or not to be
